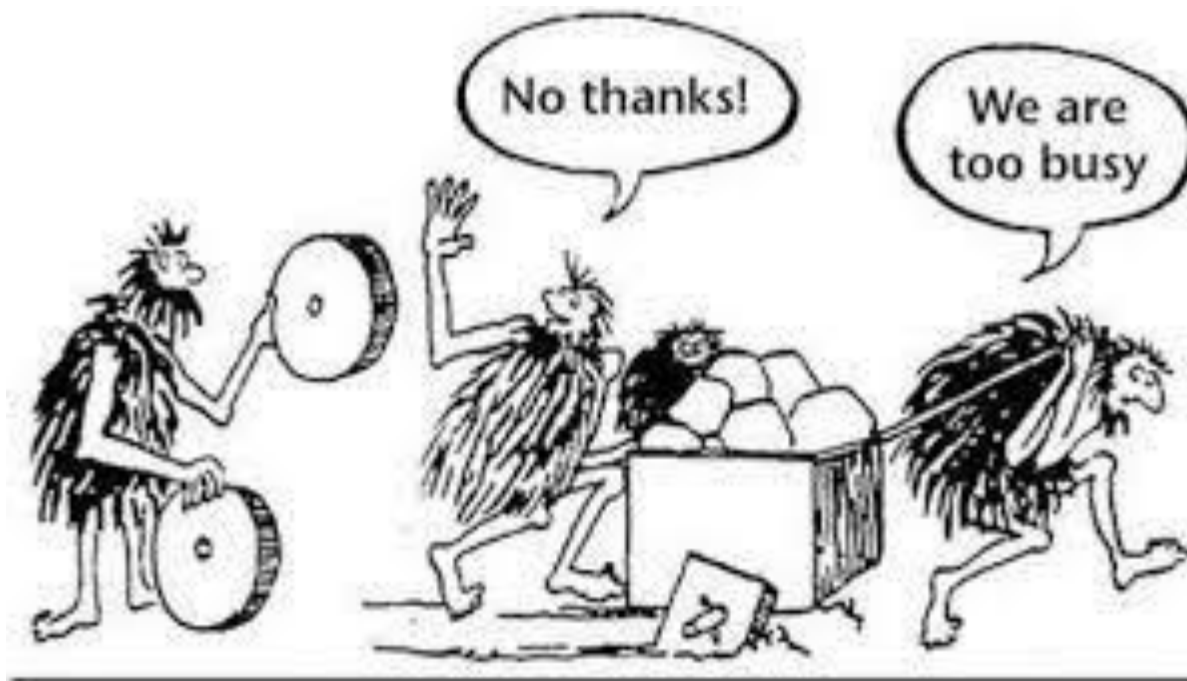

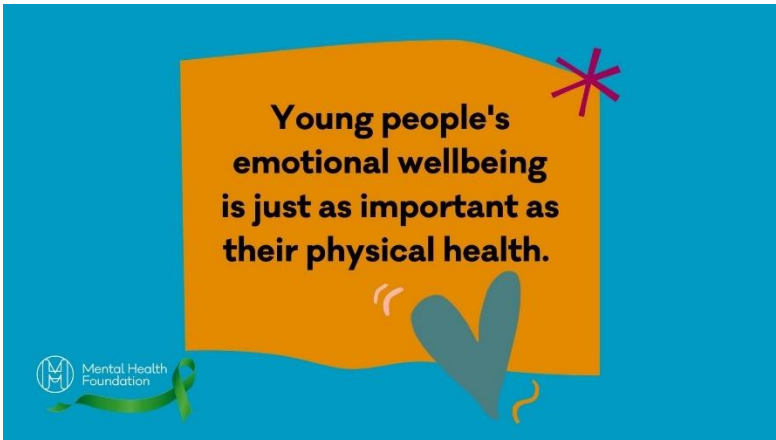

STATEMENT	TRUE OR FALSE	REASON
Young people don't experience mental health problems.	False	Young people and adults both experience mental health problems. Many issues start from a very young age and 9 in 10 of 16-24 year olds would tell friends and family they were "fine" even if they were struggling.
Someone with a mental health issue can never get better.	False	Anyone with a mental health problem can make a full recovery and feel better. All they need is help and support.
There is nothing I can do to help somebody with a mental health problem.	False	You can help a friend with a mental health problem by checking up on them, spending time with them and listening to them, without judging them.
Most people who are worried about their mental health go and see a doctor.	False	Approximately only 1 in 8 adults with a mental health problem are currently getting any kind of treatment.
Mental health is just like physical health.	True	Like physical health, mental health can get better and it can get worse. Look after it by connecting with people, keeping active, taking notice of things around you, learning new things and giving to others.
Many different people can help you with your mental health.	True	You can speak to a teacher, parent, carer or a health professional.
Financial problems and your mental health are unrelated.	False	Poor mental health can make earning and managing money harder. And worrying about money can make your mental health worse.
It is okay to describe somebody with a mental health problem as 'crazy', 'weird', 'odd', or 'mad'.	False	This is not the right way to refer to someone with a mental health problem as it might make them feel worse. It is better to say that they have a 'mental health issue', or to use a specific term like 'depressed', if you know what the problem is.



Ms Falvey and the Student Parliament have designed a whole weeks worth of resources for all year groups focussing on Mental Health and the support available for students who are struggling in school.

What does the syllabus cover?



The five-lesson mental health syllabus covers:

- Basic mental health awareness
- Risk and protective factors for our mental health
- Ways to stay well
- The importance of seeking help
- How to support others









Be a **STAR** of your emotions

We all experience different emotions from time to time. In just one day, you may feel proud, excited, sad, anxious, nervous, and many other emotions.

Remember, all feelings are valid.

Shining a light on how you feel, particularly when you're feeling overwhelmed or anxious, can help you find coping strategies to support your emotional health and wellbeing.

STOP

Take a step back from whatever you're doing.

How do your body and mind feel?

Try putting your hands on your heart and belly, then quietly count to 10.

TAKE A BREATH

Practise a breathing activity. As you gently breathe in and out, trace one finger up and down the fingers of the other hand.

How do you feel now?

AND

Continue to breathe deeply. Notice if any emotions come up; begin to label them. It's okay to not be okay! Try a sensory activity like push-ups, star jumps or using a calm down jar.

RELAX

When ready, share how you feel. Write it down, draw a picture, or talk with a trusted adult. This can help you find a way to resolve the situation. Then, do an activity to relax and let go!

To get started, follow the steps on the STAR model.

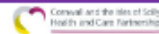

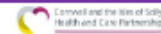
