Graduate Careers Live! is a new twice-yearly 90-minute TV programme, introducing **sixth form students**, their **parents**, and **schools' careers & university admissions staff** to the graduate job market.

Broadcasting from a studio in central London, the October programme is specifically aimed at **Year 13 students & their parents** and will showcase many of the job opportunities, occupations and professions that sixth form students can aspire to in the future.

It will provide inspiration, information and practical careers guidance on how university – or one of the growing number of degree apprenticeships – can lead to ambitious, rewarding careers in areas like **engineering, technology, banking & finance, law, accountancy** and the **public sector**.

But which universities and degree courses are most-likely to lead to a well-paid graduate job after graduation?

Which universities do the country's top employers target for their graduate recruitment?

And how can today's sixth-formers use university – or a degree apprenticeship – to develop the skills and experiences that graduate employers are looking for?

The programme features employers, recent graduates, degree apprentices, recruitment experts, and the very latest research and insight on what it takes to be successful in the competitive graduate job market.

The presenters of **Graduate Careers Live!** are **Martin Birchall**, Editor of *The Times Top 100 Graduate Employers* and **Levi Jouavel**, presenter of BBC Three's *The Catch Up* and a former BBC apprentice.

Once they've registered, students will be emailed links to their virtual work experience portals.

This programme is suitable for students in year groups Year10- Year 13 who are interested in the following careers:

- Nursing
- Midwifery
- Paramedicine
- Physiotherapy
- Occupational Therapy

 - Radiography
- Prosthetics and Orthotics
- Speech and Language Therapy

As the UCAS deadline for NHS Health Careers is in January, the sooner students begin work experience, the better.

Please forward these details to your interested students so they can participate in the monthly virtual work experience days.

During the work experience day, students will follow 2 patients from their initial presentation to recovery. They will gain a unique insight into how patients interact with a variety of healthcare professionals and what it's like to work in an NHS multidisciplinary team.

Attendees will have the opportunity to interact with healthcare professionals throughout each day. This will empower students to make an informed career decision and demonstrate their commitment to healthcare in their UCAS applications.

Students will receive certificates as evidence of having participated in the work experience programme. Those that complete the full 5-month programme will also be awarded Highly Commended References.

Students can register individually at any time throughout the 5-month programme using the link below. We recommend booking early to gain as much out of this programme as possible.

Places are £10 a session to cover administrative and technological costs.

Find out about Early Career Programmes & Apprenticeships in Horseracing

Have your students ever thought about a career in the Horseracing industry? There are various career paths they can take, some of which they may never have even thought about and a wide range of training to support them on their journey.

Foundation training at our racing schools, the National Horseracing College and the British Racing School, leads to completing an apprenticeship in a racing yard, which allows you to work hands-on with horses.

There is also an option for those that want to work with horses but maybe don't want to ride. The National Stud offers an Entry to Stud Employment Course for those with no experience handling horses, leading to a role in the breeding industry.

If media interests your students, then there is the Racing Media Academy who provide students with work experience and training at some of the largest media companies within Horseracing. This involves a one-week course at the British Racing School, followed by a paid placement in one of the many racing media outlets. **Applications are invited in November.**

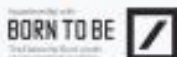

As part of our commitment to widening participation, we are delighted to launch our flagship virtual outreach programme, the Lucy Cavendish College Academic Attainment Programme, for the third year running. The programme will provide over 700 high-achieving state school students with comprehensive supplementary academic support tailored to their stage in the curriculum, giving them the best chance of achieving their full potential.

Following last year's Programme, 90% of participants feel that the AEP has provided them with the resources and support to achieve the grades they want to at A-Level (Scottish Highers/IB), and 98% of participants feel confident that they now know how to make a competitive application to Cambridge and other top universities.
