International Holocaust Memorial Day is commemorated on 27 January every year, and this year falls on Saturday 27 January 2024.


Students have been reflecting during ilearn this week and some have been preparing for a conference on Wednesday 31st January at RWBA.







Are you starting university this year?

Wiltshire Community Foundation offers grants to young people in Wiltshire and Swindon who need support with the costs of studying an undergraduate degree at university. The One Degree More bursary is £1,600 for each year of the course to help with general living expenses, course costs, books and equipment. We are now open for applications for those stating university this year.

Who is eligible to apply – young people can apply for a university bursary if they:

- are under 24 years old
- have lived in Wiltshire or Swindon for at least 2 years
- parents or guardians receive 2 means-tested benefits (2 elements of Universal Credit)
- eligible for funding through Student Finance England
- studying for first undergraduate degree at a UK university or college

Or

 are a young person in the care of Wiltshire or Swindon Borough Council (LAC)

In February the Wiltshire Air Ambulance have arranged a fundraising event to GO THE EXTRA MILE. They have asked people to celebrate February 2024, being a leap year and to challenge themselves with setting a new goal or trying something new for each day of the month.

So How Can RWBA Sixth Form GO THE EXTRA MILE?

We would like to run a challenge of our own:

to get 29 people

to do 29 challenges

over 29 Days

This would mean you would need to volunteer to do a challenge on ONE day during the month:

(More people can join in if they wish, the more the merrier, but we need a commitment of a minimum of 29).

WHAT COULD YOU DO?

You could:

 Walk, Run, Cycle, Ride, Row a mile a day at home, in the gym, local park, or at school.

We have arranged for anyone participating to be able to use the School Gym after school (3.00 - 4.00 pm - supervised) from 1 February to 29 February to do their challenge if you choose to do this option (not over half term of course). You need to get someone to take a photo of you

doing it - and why not dress up to make it more fun! All the pictures can then be used to promote the event and get more people involved.

Do a random act of kindness

For example: If you can't cook or avoid the kitchen, why not offer to prepare a meal for your family for a night, check out a recipe book and go for it!

Make 29 cupcakes and gift them to brighten someone's day who won't be expecting it.

- Do something out of the ordinary
- Learn something new in just 29 days.

THE LIST IS ENDLESS!

We would ask people to donate in support of you taking on the challenge, so you will need to drum up support from your friends and family.

The challenges need to be realistic, safe and not too complicated, but wild and wacky will be acceptable.



Like the sound of this and want to get involved? IT WILL BE FUN AND FOR A GENUINE GOOD CAUSE. You might even learn something about yourself or learn a new skill along the way.
